Why Speech?

Academic speech training develops the ability to clearly and persuasively communicate ideas with poise, courtesy, and grace. Armed with these skills, students gain the confidence they need to take a stand for what is true.

What is Junior Varsity and Junior Speech?

This course focuses on the components of a successful presentation, introducing a variety of reasons for speaking. The simple exercises in each class meeting will equip students with the skills needed to persuade, inform, delight and entertain. Students will have numerous opportunities to practice delivering speeches to other class members, and will receive lots of encouragement. Junior speech ages are 5-8 years old and Junior Varsity ages are 9-12 years old. The class is open only to siblings of RADIX and Foundations class members. Space is limited.

Guidelines and Expectations

Public speaking can be intimidating at first. Students succeed best in a safe environment in which they can learn, try, and even make mistakes. Therefore, Speech Class students will be expected to encourage one another and behave in a respectful way toward others at all times. Students are to follow the RHF dress code, and should bring a notebook and folder to each class.
